<p>Top</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Embroidered polo from Dennis Uniform (black, white, or purple) must be tucked in at all times ● Embroidered ¼ zip-up pullover, vest, or cardigan from Dennis Uniform (black) ● Black, logo-free crew neck sweatshirts are permitted only in the event of backordered warmer wear. ● Hooded sweatshirts are not allowed 	<p>Bottom</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Khaki shorts or pants from Dennis Uniform ● Mission Montessori Freemont Plaid Print Skirt from Dennis Uniform. ● Skirts and shorts may be no more than 1" above or below the knee ● Solid black or white ankle length leggings or tights are permitted under skirts during cooler weather.
<p>Shoes/Socks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Black, white, purple, or yellow closed toe tennis or dress shoes ● All shoes must be clean, free of tears, and flat soled (no heels) ● White or black shoe laces only ● Solid black or white socks. Small logos are permitted 	<p>“Free Dress” Days or Learning Expedition Absolutely no offensive messages or logos</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Shirts: must have sleeves and cover the midriff ● Bottoms: jeans (minimal rips allowed), sweatpants, or leggings are acceptable. Shorts and skirts must be a modest length. ● Shoes: must be closed toe. No Crocs or plastic shoes
<p>Hair</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Only natural colors (blonde, brown, black, auburn) are allowed. ● Conservative hairstyles only 	<p>Hats/Sunglasses</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Hats may be worn outside only ● If the hat is a distraction or deemed inappropriate, it will be confiscated ● Sunglasses are not allowed in the classroom, patio, or turf areas
<p>Jewelry</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Modest jewelry is acceptable. ● Piercings are allowed in the ears only ● Any jewelry that is a safety hazard or creates a distraction that disrupts the learning environment will be confiscated 	<p>Makeup</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● A modest amount of makeup is permitted. ● Heavy black makeup is not allowed. ● Students are not allowed to have makeup products at school or on school sponsored trips

In the event that a student is in violation of the dress code policy, the following action will be taken:

1. First Offense: Verbal Warning and Parent Communication
2. Second Offense: Give the student the uniform in question from the spirit shop; family will be charged the cost of the garment
